- ✓ are adopted from care.

Football books and magazines	Cost of books and magazines £200	To increase boys love for reading and enjoyment of books. PP child in Year 1 at expected level and made accelerated progress through year 1.
Pre teaching	SENco Teacher/TA time £500	To support understanding of learning in lessons

Behaviour support/1-1	TA time 3x a week for an hour £2500	To support child behaviour in class. Enabled child to make progress in reading(15 months) and phonics.
Family Worker	Cost of family worker all year to support PP children and their families £2000	To support children and their families
Singing Groups	TA time=2 members of staff 1 x a week for 30 minutes £250	To help support Communication and Language
