IMPORTANT: PLEASE READ THE INFORMATION BELOW CAREFULLY

NOTES TO PARENTS/CARERS

The law does not grant parents/carers an automatic right to take their children out of school during term time. If the request is for an absence in term time you must have Parental Responsibility and be the parent/carer with whom the child normally lives. Permission **must** be sought in **advance**. If the circumstances relating to this request are considered exceptional and the absence is authorised by the school, the authorising of the absences will be conditional on the child's/children's attendance being satisfactory up to the date covered by this request.

Warning: If the school refuses your request and the child is still taken out of school, this will be recorded as an unauthorised absence. Any parent who takes a child out of school for at least three consecutive school days or more, may be liable to a *Penalty Notice for each child, payable by each parent/carer, or the subject of court proceedings which could result in a fine.

*Penalty Notice £60 if paid within 21 days, increasing to £120 if paid after 21 days and before 28 days.
